The position requires at least 4 years' experience managing the landscaping needs of a large property. Experience with landscaping maintenance, fertilization, aeration, pest control and irrigation is required and licensure in these fields is preferred. Experience landscaping and painting athletic fields is also preferred. The candidate must be comfortable working outdoors in Florida's climate.
