STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ Be a positive ambassador for CSN.
- ✓ Complete all CSN assignments while away.
- ✓ Host an exchange student for one to two weeks.
- ✓ Be an active participant in another school & culture.

OVERSEAS EXPECTATIONS

In order to have a positive experience through the Global Exchange Program, students are expected to adhere to the following guidelines, more of which will be provided in site-specific materials and informational meetings:

- ◆ CSN faculty and administrators will serve as chaperones and be available through text, email, and phone as needed.
- ◆ As members of the CSN community, students are to adhere to all CSN handbook rules at all times, as if they were on campus for the duration of the exchange program. This includes no use of tobacco, alcohol, or other drugs.
- ◆ Students should behave safely and appropriately at all times. Students are responsible for all their belongings, including passports, money and luggage.

HOSTING EXPECTATIONS

One of the key components of the Global Exchange Program is hosting a student during their stay in Naples. The following are expectations for both CSN and overseas host families:

- ◆ Provide a bed in a private or shared bedroom and access to a private or shared bathroom. The room should be appropriately furnished to include: linens, pillows, blankets, and space to store belongings.
- ◆ Make the student feel welcome by including them in family and social activities.
- ◆ Provide three balanced meals a day. During school days, CSN will provide lunch to all visiting students.
- ◆ Provide transportation to and from school, as well as to various athletic and social events.
- ◆ Act as a de-facto parent, making decisions that are always in the best interest of the student's well-being, including appropriate medical care if necessary.

My family and I have read over the materials and understand the requirements and expectations of participating in the Exchange Program, including hosting an overseas student.
