

CSN MIDDLE SCHOOL DRESS CODE

The CSN dress code encourages students to dress simply and attractively in an effort to maintain a focus on learning. To ensure that students' appearance is appropriate for a school setting, compliance with the school dress code is required.

<p>Boys Daily Dress Code</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Solid colored polo-style shirt (long or short sleeves) o No logo preferred- maximum logo size is of a quarter o Solid colored shorts or trousers (non denim) o Preferably closed-toed shoes or sandals o Solid colored socks o CSN or solid colored sweaters, sweatshirts and jackets 	<p>Girls Daily Dress Code</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Solid colored polo-style shirt (long or short sleeves) o No logo preferred- maximum logo size is of a quarter o Solid colored shorts (mid-thigh), slacks, capris, skorts or skirts (all non denim). Skirts must be knee-length or longer. o Solid colored socks o Preferably closed-toed shoes or sandals o CSN or solid colored sweaters, sweatshirts and jackets
<p>Boys Spirit Day Attire (As designated by administration)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Polo-style shirt or CSN athletic/team shirts (no uniform jerseys) o Blue denim 	<p>Girls Spirit Day Attire (As designated by administration)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Polo-style shirt or CSN athletic/team shirts (no uniform jerseys) o Blue denim

<p>Clothing Not Permitted (For Boys or Girls)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Exposure to midriff o Clothing that is too tight or too baggy (spandex, jeggings, leggings, yoga pants or the like, etc...) o Changing of hair to unnatural shades (i.e.: pink, green, etc.) o Laces, zippers, hooks and eyes, snaps or any other fastener on polo. No extra zippers on pants. o Tank tops, blouses; Anything other than a polo shirt is NOT permitted o Cap sleeves on polo o Hats or visors o Hawaiian/surf shorts 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Athletic non-CSN logo clothing o Plaid shirts or shorts o Hats, bandanas, pocket chains, dog collars etc. o Body piercing other than girls' earrings. Boys may not wear earrings. Jewelry should be tasteful- no unreasonable large chains/medallions o No athletic pants or shorts o Tattoos o Facial hair o Cell phones, iPods or CD players during the school day o No Apple watches and other smart watches

The interpretation and appropriateness of the dress code will be subject to the discretion of the Division Head. Students not dressed in the appropriate dress code may be asked to call home for appropriate clothing to be delivered; or loaned appropriate clothes from office (if available); or sent to bookstore to purchase appropriate clothing which will be billed to the students' account. Special dress code may be required for field trips at the teachers' discretion. If no specific dress code is stated, students must follow the Middle School dress code guidelines. Students are required to wear athletic shoes when participating in P.E. and any science labs.
